<b>Emergency benefit for temporary visa holders</b>	If you've got a temporary visa and are in financial hardship, we may be able to help you with an Emergency Benefit. Applying for this benefit won't affect any visa application you may have with Immigration New Zealand. This support is ending on 31 August 2021. <b>More information <a href="#">here</a></b>
<b>Wage Subsidy Scheme August 2021</b>	Helps eligible businesses to continue paying employees and keep them on. The subsidy will pay \$600 for full-time employees and \$359 for part-time employees and applications can be made from 20 August. <b>More information <a href="#">here</a></b>
<b>Short-Term Absence Payment</b>	Provides businesses with a one-off (once per 30 days) payment of \$359 for employees who must miss work due to a COVID-19 test and can't work from home. <b>More information <a href="#">here</a></b>
